DEVELOPMENT (CONTROL OF EXTERNAL PAINTING) AMENDMENT BILL

Mr PICCOLO (Light) (11:38): I move:

That this bill be now read a third time.

I commend the bill to the house, for the reasons I have outlined. While I am aware that the opposition is trying to suggest improbabilities as a way of stalling this measure, I have to admit that the bill is in some ways a reminder bill but it is a very important bill. I have no doubt that if there are any faults in it they will be sorted out in the other place.
